

Dear Friends and Customers:

Since our grandfather planted his first vine in 1934, the Ison family has enjoyed a long relationship with the muscadine grape. What started out as a modest 3 acre vineyard has evolved into over 40 acres of vineyard and a nursery offering over 200 varieties of fruit, nut and berry plants. In the late 1960's Dr. B. O. Fry and our father began breeding muscadines in order to improve size, taste and production. From the fruit of their labor we now have 22 patented varieties of muscadines! These varieties are considered the best for commercial vineyards, u-pick operations and the backyard hobbyist. There is nothing more enjoyable than planting, cultivating and harvesting fruit from your own orchard or vineyard.

As I write this letter there is no doubt this is my favorite time of year, muscadine season, How wonderful this fruit is and what a wonderful opportunity it is to harvest and sell the fruit. Demand for muscadine fruit is at an all-time high, many growers have told me that they have not had to make one sales call, the customers are calling the growers, and that's a good sign indeed. We see this as a trend, as more consumers become aware of the fruit and the health benefits, the demand nationally is going to grow and will need additional fruit to harvest for this demand. I believe now is the most exciting time the muscadine industry has ever seen, and now is a great time to start planting.

Tips to prevent or minimize cold weather damage.

- Fertilize twice a year. Once in April and again after fruit set.
- If there is an over abundant crop remove 12-15 clusters of grapes in early July.
- Irrigate from the spring until the fall if the weather is warm and dry.

** NEW MUSCADINE VARIETY RELEASES **

Dr. Patrick Conner at the University of Georgia has released two new muscadine varieties. His breeding efforts has been focused on larger self-fertile varieties with a higher dry scar percentage and an improved shelf life.

LANE is an early season black self-fertile variety that is 1 1/8" diameter. It is comparable to SUPREME with firmness and shelf life although not as large.

HALL is an early to mid-season bronze self-fertile, also 1 1/8" diameter. It is slightly smaller than FRY. It rarely splits when harvesting the fruit. It has a high dry scar. Both of these new releases will be a great addition to your vineyard.

We have another outstanding inventory of plants this year. We are also very pleased with the quality of the plants that are offered this shipping season. In the muscadine vines we offer the two year old bare-root plants that are 3-4' in length, the 2-year plus which are 4' and longer, and the 2 year potted plants which are shipped in the containers. The 2-year plus are our finest plants, most of them reach or are very close to reaching the top wire at planting.

Take advantage of our fertilizer lines for your fruiting plants and trees. We have specially blended these fertilizers to ensure a healthy start during the spring and summer months. See page 23.

The plant shelters continue to improve muscadine vine growth and herbicide protection. We recommend using them for all new plantings. And our line of muscadine juice, jellies, and supplements will allow you to enjoy muscadine flavors year round. See page 6 and 25.

Drip irrigation will benefit your fruit trees and plants by increasing fruit size, earlier production, and heavier yields, This year we have converted our irrigation fitting from compression lock to power lock which makes it much easier to install the tees, elbows and other fittings. See page 26.

MUSCADINES

There is nothing more enjoyable than planting and harvesting fruit from muscadine vines. The muscadine is native to the Southeastern U.S. and thrives in our hot and humid growing conditions. The vines can easily be grown organically since they require little or no spraying. They can safely be grown from the coastal side of New York south to Florida, and west to Missouri, Kansas, Oklahoma, and Texas. They also can be grown in parts of New Mexico, Arizona, and the coastal sides of California, Oregon, and Washington state. If you select a female variety you must have a self-fertile variety within 50 feet of any female variety. Muscadines average between 50-60 lbs per female plant and 60-80 lbs per self-fertile plant. A black self-fertile plant can pollinate a bronze female and vice/versa. Muscadines are one of nature's richest sources of polyphenolic antioxidants, the potential health benefits include preliminary evidence for effects against cancer mechanisms, so not only are they fun to grow and eat they also are very healthy for you.

Available Plant Sizes

2 Year Bare-root – The majority of the plants we grow are 2 year bare-root. The average length of these vines are 3-4' with an excellent root system.

2 Year Plus Bare-root – These are the largest and highest quality plants that we offer. They have had exceptional growth, have an excellent root system and average 4-6 foot in length. These vines will be very close to reaching the top wire on your trellis.

Muscadine Planting Instructions

Plants produce best in full sun in well-drained soil. Muscadine grapes require a pH level around 6.5. Plant spacing of 20' in commercial vineyard and 15' in home vineyard with rows 10' apart. Recommend trellis constructed of 6 1/2' post set 2' in ground. Use 9 gauge galvanized wire. Female muscadine vines require pollination by a self-fertile variety. We recommend planting a self-fertile variety within 50 feet of each female. Usually in large plantings we plant 3 rows of females and then 1 row of self-fertile pollinators. This provides ample pollination. On single row plantings you may space your pollinators throughout the row. Plants begin producing fruit 2nd year. Follow chart below for proper fertilization.

Muscadine Fertilization Program

Apply in circle out from plant about 12 inches

1/4 lb. of Ison's Custom Muscadine Fertilizer or 1st year: 10-10-10 on April 1, May 1, June 1, and July 1.

1/4 lb. Calcium Nitrate on the 15th of same months.

2nd year: Double the amount and administer the same time as 1st year. Same applies for Calcium Nitrate.

3rd year: Apply 3 lbs. of Ison's Custom Muscadine Fertilizer or

10-10-10 on April 15th.

4th year: Apply 3 lbs. of Ison's Custom Muscadine Fertilizer or 10-10-10 on April 15th depending on type of soil and

amount of plant growth.

Jumbo - Black Female. 15% sugar. Large fruit size, vine is vigorous, disease resistant and cold hardy. Must allow fruit to fully ripen to be sweet. Ripens mid-season. Available in 2yr bare-root only.

Scuppernong - Bronze Female. 17% sugar. Good flavor with average size clusters. Vine is vigorous, cold hardy with good quality. Ripens mid-season. Available in 2yr bare-root only.

Summit - Red Female. 20% sugar. Excellent quality with great production. Medium to large size fruit. Edible skin. Consistant producer. Vine is vigorous, dry scar, cold hardy and disease resistant. Ripens early to mid-season. Available in 2yr, 2yr plus, 2yr potted.



Noble - Black Self-fertile. 16% sugar. Medium size, good quality with large clusters. The standard for making red wine. Very vigorous, high yields, cold hardy. Edible skin, disease resistant. Ripens mid-season. Available in 2yr, 2yr plus, 2yr potted.

Ison's Nursery & Vineyard has been growing muscadine vines since the early 1930's. In fact, we have been told that we are the largest grower of muscadine vines in the world. With a strong desire to develop the muscadine market we planted a seedling vineyard in the late 1960's. Our dad Bill Ison and Dr. B.O. Fry began breeding muscadines on our farm in order to improve size, taste and production. They developed and released dozens of new varieties of muscadine's and were granted more than 32 patents. The muscadine breeding program still continues in our vineyard today. The premium varieties listed below were developed on our farm and we are proud to say that many of them are considered to be the best for commercial vineyards, u-pick operations, and the back yard hobbyist.





Developing the Muscadine Vine



- (1) At planting, prune all side growth. Find longest runner and prune off all other side growth.
- (2) Keep all side growth removed from trunk area leaving only leaves that are closest to the trunk.
- (3) Once vine reaches top of wire, lead vine down wire in one direction and wait for a sucker to put out and lead down wire in other direction.
- (4) Allow side growth off main vine growing down wire to grow 6" long then pinch tip off every 10-12 days until main vine reaches 10' in each direction.
- (5) Once vines reaches 10' down the wire, keep main vine cut back to 10' and allow growth back to side growth.

PLANTING YOUR FRUIT TREE





- Set tree in hole with the roots on top of the mound. The graft line of the tree should be about 3" above the ground. Adjust the height of the mound if necessary.
- Spread the roots evenly in all directions.
- Fill hole with soil and firm gently with your foot. Check that the tree is vertical. Be sure to "overfill" the hole so the soil is an inch or two above the ground level. The soil will compress when watered and settle to ground level.
- Stake if necessary. Tie the tree to stake with a rubber tie or piece of cloth.

DRIP IRRIGATION

What is Drip Irrigation? Drip irrigation is the slow application of water directly to the plant's root zone. Drip irrigation can provide optimum moisture level in the soil at all times, resulting in less water lost to the sun and wind. With drip irrigation, water is not wasted on non-growth areas, and the root zone is maintained at a steady moisture level, combining the proper balance of water and air for a very efficient irrigation system.

Drip irrigation can be used to ensure proper watering of all of your plant needs including berries, fruit trees, grapes and even gardens.

How does it benefit a vineyard? Drip irrigation in vineyards provides excellent water management, allows better fruit production and reduces problems of unwanted mold growth. It also ensures large fruit size and fruit quality. A shortage of available soil moisture greatly reduces the normal growth rate of a grapevine. Grapevines are quite tolerant to drought, but when heavily stressed, plant growth almost stops.




When is the best time to water?

Water in the morning, when humidity is high and temperature is low. Allow the soil to dry slightly between watering. This enables air to mix with the soil particles and aid

in plant growth. For the backyard grower we recommend watering three times a week for 8 - 10 hours at a time. If you have had a lot of rainfall, this would be decreased.

SHIPPING SEASON


We will begin shipping plants the first week of December or as the plants become dormant. (Plants must be dormant before we begin shipping.) We will ship through April 30th. (Note: See our guarantee below.) These are approximate dates. Muscadine and berry plants are usually ready December 1st or earlier. Some fruit trees may not be ready until late December or early January. To save on shipping costs, we prefer to ship your order once everything is available.

UPON RECEIPT OF MERCHANDISE

If your plants arrive and you are unable to plant them immediately, store in cool dry place where they will not freeze. Plants will keep for 3-4 days after receipt. It is important to ensure that the roots do not dry out. If plants are frozen upon receipt, allow them to thaw completely then plant as directed. If you cannot plant within the above time frame, you may keep plants alive by putting in a trench and covering roots with dirt or using a large bucket to cover roots with dirt and keep roots damp.




